Sub: Pattana Haritha Haram -TKHH2020 – Preparatory activities and measures for Plantation – Pitting work and other action points - Certain instructions issued – Regarding.

The attention of all the Municipal Commissioners in the State are invited to the reference 8th and 9th cited, wherein specific instructions are issued regarding preparatory work for taking up of Pattana Haritha Haram -TKH2020 which is a flagship program of the State.

2. In this regard, the Hon'ble Minister for MA & UD during the Video Conference held on 13.6.2020 has given the following directions for strict compliance:

- Pattana Haritha Haram program to be started in all the ULBs from 20th June.
- Targets are fixed for the ensuing Haritha Haram program and ULBs shall take up program accordingly.
- To involve of all elected representatives, officials, ward committee members, SLFs, SHGs, RWAs, & citizens in the Haritha Haram program.
- Ensure 10% Green Budget is provided in every ULB and the same is utilized 100% for intended purpose. An audit will be taken up on expenditure of Green Budget. The Municipal Commissioners will be held responsible for non-utilization of Green Budget.
- As per provisions of 85% of plants are ensured for survival, else action will be initiated as per the provisions of the Act.

- Ensure atleast one Nursery in each ULB and in Bigger ULBs more nurseries as required to be planned
 - Take up Avenue Plantation with tall plants with a minimum of 6 feet height. All approach roads of town to be covered.
 - Plantations also be planned with Boganvilla, Mosquito repellent plants and Ornamental plants and taking up
 - Miyawaki plantation
 - urban lung spaces development
 - municipal open spaces plantations
 - Schools, Collages, govt institutions, offices plantations
 - plantations at Lakes
 - Dump yards (taking up Aromatic Plants)
 - Smrithivanam
 - All ULBs shall have data of plantation made and survival of plants.
 - Ensure Fibre Tree guards of 5 feet height, 4 feet width (last year it ranges from Rs.145 to 165)
 - Water tanker for watering plants
 - Capture before and after photographs of plantation
 - Every Friday to be observed as Harith Sukravaram.
3. In the reference 4th cited (copy enclosed), Government have communicated the instructions of Chief Secretary to Government. The following points were discussed and have been directed to implement the same that are pertaining to MA & UD Department:

3.1 Development of atleast one Tree Park in each of the ULB with Gravel pathway and only tree species to be planted with no grass turfing, no hedges, no flowering plants etc. It must have a Walking pathway of Morum (Gravel) with a width of 1.5 to 3.0 mts depending upon the size of the site. The espacement adopted may be 2m x2m (i.e., 2mts. distance between two rows & in each row each tree is 2 mts apart) or 3m x 2m. The species which are used for avenue like Raavi, Vepa, Kadamba, Mahogany, Pagoda, Marri, Ippa etc., and flowering avenue plants like Millingtonia(kadamalle/Boddumalle), Spathodia, Tecoma Argentina, Peltropharam, Gulmohar,Tabubia, Cassia, Bauhinia, Jacarana etc.

3.2 Every ULB shall have one “Miyawaki Park”.

3.3 (90) ULBs are having Forest Blocks within 5 Kms of Municipalities. It is proposed to adopt and develop one such Urban Forest Block by each of these (90) ULBs with their green budget. In case of Forest Blocks are having large areas, as in case of Yellandu Block which has 15807 Ha., then they can adopt a part of it, say 5 to 10% of the area treating it as Visitors Zone & balance area could be with Forest Dept. as Conservative Zone. This may be discussed with the local DFOs & CCFs / CFs and finalize.

3.4 The Officers are requested to follow the instructions scrupulously and improve the greenery in the ULBs.

4. In this regard, the Municipal Commissioners are hereby instructed that in respect of plants for distribution, they can procure the same from Homestead plants from Nurseries developed by SHGs under MEPMA SEP only and for the tall plants, they shall procure through DPC headed Dist Collector or as approved

by Dist Collector of the Green Committee.

5. The Municipal Commissioners shall ensure to conduct meeting with ward Committee members /RWAs for colony plantations in a big way by involving SLFs, SHGs, NGOs and strategy to be worked out in supporting pitting. It is also suggested that to take up dense plantation at lakes & nalas with trees and flowering shrubs..
6. All the Municipal Commissioners to follow above instructions scrupulously.
